

Vaish Mahila Mahavidyalya, Rohtak

Annual Report (Session 2023-24)

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Vaish Mahila Mahavidyalya, Rohtak is one of leading institutions of higher education for women in the state and has made significant contribution in promoting and spreading women education in the region. Since its inception as a 'girls' wing' of Vaish College, Rohtak in 1973, the college has been constantly moving on the path of progress and was granted the status of an independent Girls' College affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak in 1992. It is a Govt. aided private institution run by the prestigious Vaish Education Society, Rohtak according to the rules and regulations of the state government and UGC. The girls belonging to both urban and rural areas seek admission in the college in different courses. In the current session, approximately 1160 students have been enrolled in the college.

The boarding facilities are also being provided to the girl students belonging to far off areas through the girls' hostel of the college. The college is equipped with all the necessary ICT tools for improving and raising the quality of education in order to keep pace with the changing scenario in the field of education. A language lab has been established in the college for enhancing communication skills of the students in English language. An auditorium has also been constructed for promoting and organizing cultural and co-curricular activities in the college.

Courses Available in the College

Regular courses both at undergraduate and post graduate level are being offered by the college. These include – B.A. (Pass), B.Com.(Pass), B.Com. (Hons.), B.Sc.(Non-Medical),BCA, BBA, M.A. (English), M.A. (Hindi), M.A.(Economics), M.Com, M.Sc. (Maths) and M.Sc. (Computer Science).Out of these, B.A. (Pass) and B.Com. (Pass)courses are aided by Haryana Govt. and B.Com.(Hons), BBA, BCA, B.Sc. and PG courses are run under self-financing scheme. Besides these courses, an add-on course in Fashion Designing is also being offered to the students in the college.

Teaching and Non Teaching Staff

There are 50 (12 aided + 38 SFS full time) teaching staff members and 18 (aided + 16 SFS) non-teaching staff members employed in the college for the smooth running of academic and non-academic work in the college. Dr. Rashmi Gupta, who took over the charge of the Principal of the college in 2019, has been serving her duty efficiently for the last 5 years.

College Library

The library plays an important role in the growth of the academic standard in an institution. Keeping in view the interest and academic demand of the students, the college has a well-stocked library. There are approximately 17,500 books of different subjects in the library at present. In addition to books,16newspapers, 6 research journals and 34 magazines of general knowledge and competitive exams are subscribed in the library.

Besides these, the membership of three online research journals (N-List, Delnet, Shodh Sindhu) has also been taken for research related activities of the staff and students. There is also provision for issuing of subject related books to the students on merit and economic basis for the whole year.

Academic Achievements

The main objective of the college is to empower young women through higher education and provide a conducive environment for quality education. The entire process of implementation of curriculum revolves around the objective of the institution. The results of the college, which have been better than university results in most of the courses, is a factual proof of its academic standard. Every year, our students get position among top ten in the university merit list. In the university examination held in 2023-24, six students of our college got position among top ten in the university merit list. Tanya (BCA 1st sem.) got 5th position, Sakshi (BCA 3rd sem. got 10th position, Mehak (B.Com. pass 3rd sem.) got 6th position, Dikshu (B.Com.Hons 5th sem.) got 7th position, Tanya (B.Sc.Non-Medical 5th sem.) got 4th position and Anjali (B.Sc.Non Medical 5th sem.) got 9th position in the university merit list.

Cultural and Literary Achievements

The students of the college also excel in cultural, literary and fine arts events organised at Zonal and Inter Zonal youth festivals and also at various Inter College, Division and State Level Competitions. In Zonal Youth Festival held at Gaur Brahmin Degree College, Rohtak (from 29th October to 31st October 2023), our students got three prizes in fine arts events; Nitika won first prize in Best Out of Waste, Tulsi won first prize in Collage Making and Neetu won 3rd prize in Cartooning. In literary activities, Pratibha got 2nd prize in Hindi Poetic Recitation in Zonal Youth Festival.

In Inter Zonal Youth Festival held at Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak (from Nov. 4-6, 2023), our student Pratibha won third prize in Hindi Poetic Recitation and Neetu got third prize in Cartooning. In Inter-College Techno Management Fest organised by Vaish College of Engineering, Rohtak from 28th Feb to 1st March, 2024, our college students won 11 prizes in different

events. In fine arts events, Bhumi won 1st prize in Rangoli, Vrinda won 2nd prize in Collage Making, Nitika won 2nd prize in Best Out of Waste, Meena won 2nd prize in Poster Making, Dimple won 2nd prize in Mehendi and Gauri won 2nd prize in Photography. In literary events, Divya won 1st prize in Debate (against the motion). In cultural events, our students won 1st prize in Solo Singing, 2nd in Duet dance and also 2nd in Solo dance.

In inter college-department Quiz Competition organised by Students' Welfare Department, M.D. University, Rohtak under Viksit Bharat Abhiyan on 20/01/24, our college students won 2nd prize. In "Rang Sur" event organised by M.D.U., Rohtak on 21.03.2024, our student got consolation prize in Solo Singing.

In District Level Legal Literacy Competitions held at Government College, Sampla on 26.04.2024, Divya got 1st prize in PowerPoint Presentation and Annu got 3rd prize in Essay Writing Competition. In Division Level Literacy Competitions held at Govt. College, Sampla on 24.07.2024, Annu got 1st prize in Essay Writing Competition. Annu also got 1st prize in the same competition in State Level Legal Literacy Competitions at Government College for Women, Sector 14, Panchkula.

Sports Achievements

The college has an enviable track record in games and sports. Our players have scaled new heights in various sports events at International, National and State level in the session 2023-24. The achievements of our college in the field of sports are as follows:

*Our Sports students got position in various Inter College Championships organised by M.D.U., Rohtak during the session. In Kabaddi (N.S.) Championship held on Oct 24-25, 2023 and in Kho-Kho Championship held on Nov. 25-28, 2023 at Vaish Mahila Mahavidyalya, Rohtak, our students got first

position. In various Inter College events organized at Sport Complex, M.D.U., Rohtak – Judo Championship held on Nov. 11, 2023; Kabaddi (CS) Championship held on Dec. 1,2023; Baseball Championship held on March 18-19,2024; Softball Championship held on April 22-23, 2024 and in Weight Lifting Championship held on 20.12.2023, our students got second position. In Inter College Football Championship held Pt. Neki Ram Sharma Govt. College, Rohtak on Nov. 18-19, 2023 our team got third position.

- Our player, Gyan Bharati participated in North Zone Cricket Championship held at Shimla, Himachal Pradesh from Nov. 16, 2023 to Nov. 22, 2023 and her team got 3rd position.
- Our player Varaha Garlanka participated in North Zone Hockey Championship held at Punjabi University, Patiala and her team got 2nd position.
- Our 5 players participated in All India Inter University Kabaddi (CS) Championship held at CRSU, Jind on Feb. 6-8, 2024 and their team got 3rd position.
- Our 5 players participated in North Zone Kho-Kho Championship held at LPU, Phagwara and their team got 2nd position.
- Our players Deepak and Priti participated in Junior National Kho-Kho Championship held at Karnail Singh Stadium, Delhi and also in Khelo India League Tournament of KhoKho held at Indore from 26.08.2023 to 28.08.2023 and their team got second position in both the tournaments.
- Our 5 players (Tannu, Anshul, Komal,Varsha &Priya) participated in All India Inter Zonal National Soft-ball Championship held at Saint John Marie Higher Secondary School, Alangapuram, Salem on April 13-14, 2024 and got bronze medal.

- Nidhi got Gold medal in Senior Grappling Championship and Silver medal in Grappling GI Championship in World Championship-2023 held in Russia on November 18-19, 2023.
- Nidhi and Saren participated in National Grappling Championship-2023 held at M.D.U., Rohtak from 29.09.2023 to 02.10.2023 and won gold medal and silver medal respectively.
- Saren, Tannu and Riya participated in JU-JITSU National Championship held at Multi-Purpose hall, Dehradun, Uttarakhand on Feb 23-25, 2024 in which Saren won gold medal and Tannu and Riya won bronze medals.
- Our six players have been selected for All India Inter University Softball team of M.D.U., Rohtak.
- Annual Athletic Meet of the college was held on 1st& 2nd March, 2024 in which Sushma (B.A. III) got Best Athlete award.

Formation of Various Cells and Clubs

Different cells and clubs/units like Students' Welfare and Anti-Ragging Cell, Women Cell, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Legal Literacy Cell, Placement Cell, SC/BC Cell, Tobacco Cell, Red Ribbon Club, Eco-Club, N.S.S. Unit and Youth Red Cross Unit etc. have been set up in the college to achieve a holistic development of the students through a rigorous program conducted under these cells and clubs.

STUDENTS' WELFARE/REDRESSAL CELL

Students' Welfare cell organised an orientation program at the beginning of new session (on 12.08.2023) to give the new students a general introduction to the college rules, infrastructure facilities, time-table and different co-curricular and extra-curricular activities conducted by different cells and committees. Anti-ragging day was also celebrated on the same day with the students taking oath to follow anti-ragging law and screening of a documentary

on anti-ragging. Various lectures and speeches were organized by the cell during the session for the welfare of the students such as an extension lecture on Cyber Crime on 21.08.2023; a motivational speech delivered by Divya, Jyoti, Jagriti, Sansthan, and a lecture by eminent skin specialist, Dr. R.K. Bansal on 'How to Avoid Common Mistakes in Case of Serious Burns and Allergies' on 8.09.2023. The Students' Welfare Cell also organised activities like 'Lohri Function' on 14.01.2024, a 'Get Together Party' for UG& PG students on 18.04.2024 and Parents-Teachers Meet on 16.08.2024.

N.S.S. Unit & Outreach Activity Club

N.S.S. Unit and Outreach Activity Club aim to groom the students as socially responsible citizens by holding one-day and seven-days camps and different activities for them throughout the session. This session, N.S.S. Unit organised a Poster-Making competition in collaboration with Youth Red Cross Unit of the college on 'Drug Abuse' on 5th Sept. 2023. On 5th Oct., 2023, N.S.S. Unit of the college in collaboration with N.S.S. Unit of M.D.U., Rohtak organized State Level Online Transformational Stories of N.S.S. Volunteers in which students from various institutions across the state participated. On 12th Nov. 2023, N.S.S. Unit organized a debate in English and a poster-making competition. A seven-day day & night camp was organised by N.S.S. Unit and Outreach Activity Club from 15th March to 22nd March, 2024 in which 50 N.S.S. Volunteers participated in different activities organized for their all-around development and also went to slum area for doing social service. Besides these, N.S.S. Volunteers of the college attended various activities organized by M.D.U., Rohtak; 20 Volunteers participated in celebration of Kargil Vijay Diwas in R.K. Auditorium, M.D.U., Rohtak on 26.07.2023; 16 Volunteers participated in 'Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation Training' organized by N.S.S. Unit, M.D.U., Rohtak on 01.09.2023; 20 Volunteers participated in Nasha Mukti Abhiyan on International Day Against Drug Abuse & Illicit

Traffick in gat R.K. Auditorium on 03.09.2023 and 18 Volunteers participated in One-day Tree Plantation Programme organized by Horticulture & Campus Forestry Committee & EMS Cell, M.D.U., Rohtak on 26.09.2023. Outreach Activity Club organised an awareness rally on 'Environmental Pollution & Plastic Waste Management' on 27.07.2023 and a two-day cleanliness drive (on 1st, 2nd Oct.2023) on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti at Rohtak Railway Station.

Women Cell

Women Cell organized a lecture on 'Sexual Harassment' by Dr. Ritika Sharma on 7.10.2023 and a talk on 'Eve Teasing' by Sh. Virender Singh, DSP, Rohtak on 8.11.2023. A Slogan Writing competition was organized by Women Cell on 'Gender Sensitization' on 18.03.2024.

Legal Literacy Cell

Legal Literacy Cell of the College organized a Declamation Contest and Poetic-Recitation Competition on various socio-legal issues on 07.03.2024 in the college. On behalf of Legal Literacy Cell of the College, nine students of our college participated in District Level Legal Literacy Competitions organized at Govt. College, Sampla on 26.04.2024; two students of the college participated in Division level Legal Literacy Competitions also held at Govt. College, Sampla on 24.07.2024 and one student participated in State Level Legal Literacy Competition held at GCW, Sector-14, Panchkula on 30.7.2024 and won prizes.

Eco-Club

Eco-club in collaboration with N.S.S. Unit and Youth Red Cross Club of the College organised 'Tree Plantation' activity in the college on 24.07.2023 on the occasion of Kargil Diwas Celebration. All the teaching and non teaching staff members and students participated in the activity. About 50 saplings were planted in pots and college garden during the plantation drive.

Red Ribbon Club

Red Ribbon club has been formed in the college to raise awareness of HIV/AIDS among the students and the need to prevent it. On the occasion of International Youth Day (19-08-2023), various activities were organised by Red Ribbon Club like a Poster Making competition on HIV/AIDS and Environmental Consciousness; an extension lecture on HIV/AIDS by Dr. Asha, Civil Hospital, Rohtak; screening of documentary on “Teach Aids” and participation of students in Red Ribbon Human Chain. Red Ribbon Club organized a people awareness rally on World Aids Day (01-12-2023) and activities like Tree Decoration, promotion of Toll Free no.& NACCO AIDS App and formation of Red Ribbon Human Chain by students were also held on the same day. During the celebration of National Youth Day (12th to 26th Jan.2024), Red Ribbon club organised various competitions like Poster-Making, Nail Art and Pot- Making. An extension lecture on "Mental Health Awareness" by Dr. Vipin Nain, Psychiatrist, Civil Hospital, Rohtak was held on 07-03-2024 under Red Ribbon club. Two teachers and six students of Red Ribbon Club participated in training programme on 03.11.2023 organised by District Nodal Officer, HIV/AIDS, Rohtak.

Tobacco Cell

Tobacco cell organised a Poster- Making Competition on “Quit Tobacco” on 05-09-2023 in the college. An “Anti- Tobacco” rally was organised by the cell on 15-04-2024 to spread awareness about ill- effects of tobacco consumption among people.

Youth Red Cross Club

Youth Red Cross Club of the college organised a lecture on “Eye Donation” by Dr. Dinesh Sharma in collaboration with Rotary Club, Rohtak on 28-08-2023 to make students aware of the importance of post mortal eye

donation. On the occasion of World Health Day (08-04-2024), lectures on health awareness were organised by the club in which Dr. Suhas Kirti Singla told the students about causes and remedies of cancer and Dr. Charu Gupta apprised them about gastro problems. Eleven YRC volunteers participated in District level Course Camp organised by Vaish College, Rohtak and got prizes in various events.

IQAC Cell

Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC) has been making constant efforts to stimulate academic environment in the college for promotion of quality of education. IQAC of the college organised a lecture on “Entrepreneurship” by Professor R.K Mittal, Vice Chancellor, CBLU, Bhiwani on 02-09-2023. The members of IQAC filled up AQAR of the session 2022-2023 in Jan. 2024 and also submitted SSR-24 for NAAC accreditation of the college.

SC/BC Cell

SC/BC Cell of the college recommends the names of economically deprived SC/BC students for scholarship from the State Govt. and also helps them get fee concession and other facilities. During the session 2023-2024, the names of 116 SC students were approved by the State Govt. for scholarship and the scholarship has been dispersed to 115 SC students as yet. The names of 55 BC students have been approved by the State Govt. for scholarship which has not been dispersed as yet. One student of our college got State Merit Scholarship for UG/PG students of the amount Rs.3600/-.

Placement Cell

The Placement Cell of the college helps students in getting placement in various companies after the completion of their graduation. On behalf of the Placement Cell of the college, students attended ‘Placement Fair’ held at Pt. Neki Ram Sharma Govt. College, Rohtak on 31-01-2024 in which various leading

companies came to offer placement to eligible candidates. Eight students of our college got placement in these companies. On 12.06.2024, the college hosted the NIIT Placement Drive conducted by Axis Bank for the post of Assistant Manager in which 12 students of our college were selected for the next round to be held soon.

Alumni Association

An Alumni Association has also been constituted in the college registered as “Sangini Alumni Association” which organizes Alumni Meets from time to time to keep contact with the former students of the college and get their feedback on college and faculty. Alumni Association of the college organised ‘Alumni Meet’ on 28.04.2024 in which many of the former students of the college participated and shared their experiences with the teachers and students.

Departmental Activities

Various departmental committees and societies have also been constituted in the college in order to promote students' interest in academic and co-curricular activities. Music department and Literary Committee of the College organised ' Talent Show' for new comers on 22-08-2023 in which students showed their talents in singing, dancing, poetic-recitation and declamation etc. Music Department also organised an Inter-class competition on Classical Music - Rag and Tal on 15-03-2024.

Economics department organised Declamation contest on 29-09-2023 and on ‘Different Govt. Schemes' on 19-03-2024, A Wall Making Competition on Budget was also organised by Economics department on 20.03.2024.

Commerce Department Organised a ‘Rakhi Making Competition on 25-08-2023 and extension lectures on “Tally & GST” on 18-09-23 and ‘GST Returns (with demos) by Mr. Mukesh Juneja on 20-02-24. English department organised an

Essay Writing competition on current issues on 20-10-2023 and a Story-Telling competition on the occasion of 'World Story- Telling Day' on 20-03-2024.

Hindi department organized a Declaration Contest on the occasion of Hindi Diwas on 14-09-2023. On the occasion of National Language Day in India, Hindi department organized various activities like Essay-Writing, Poetic-Recitation, Painting and Slogan writing competitions and activities like a Nuked Natak, Moving Food Corner and Language Stall. Mathematics Department organised Power Point Presentation competition for UG and PG students on ‘Mathematics Skills in Daily Life on 13-10-2023 and a Maths Quiz competition on 11-03-2024.

New Courses

The college has applied for starting two new courses under self financing scheme to M. D. University, Rohtak - M.A. Political Science and M.A. History. The admission in these courses will be started from the next session.

Achievements of Teaching Faculty

The teaching faculty members of the college are nominated as members of different important committees of the University by M.D.U., Rohtak. Principal Dr. Rashmi Gupta has been nominated as member of Academic Council and a member of UMC Committee of the University. She has also been appointed as a member of Jury of Appeal in Youth Festival ‘Spandan 2023’ held at Gaur Brahmin Degree College, Rohtak. Dr. Sujeet Neema has been nominated as a member of Sports Executive Board and Sports Council of M.D.U., Rohtak. Dr. Santosh Mittal and Dr. Anjana Bansal have been nominated as members of Board of Studies for UG classes by the University.

Teaching faculty members also publish books and research papers in various journals for their career advancement. Dr. Surjeet Kaur Neema published a book entitled ‘Health Education, Organisation and Administration in Physical Education’ during the session 2023-2024. Teaching faculty also participated in various seminars, workshops and conferences organised at state and national levels and also presented papers during the session.
